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ADDITIONAL REMARK ON SOLOVYOV'S SO-CALLED
NOVA AQUILAE 1949

Schaefer (1987) recently reminded the owners of plate collections on Solovyov's (1949) forgotten announcement of a possible nova in Aquila.

Solovyov's plate was of 2 May 1949 21^h42^m0 UT. In the Sonneberg collection there is a patrol plate, taken on the same night by H. Huth on 3 May 1949 0^h50^m - 1^h30^m UT, which shows no trace of a star at the given position. Because the time of exposure is about 3^h.5 later than that of the discovery plate and since our limiting magnitude is not better than 11^m.5, our negative observation can only intensify the statement that no confirmation of Solovyov's finding exists.

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
